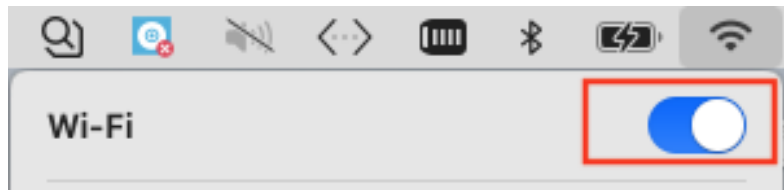
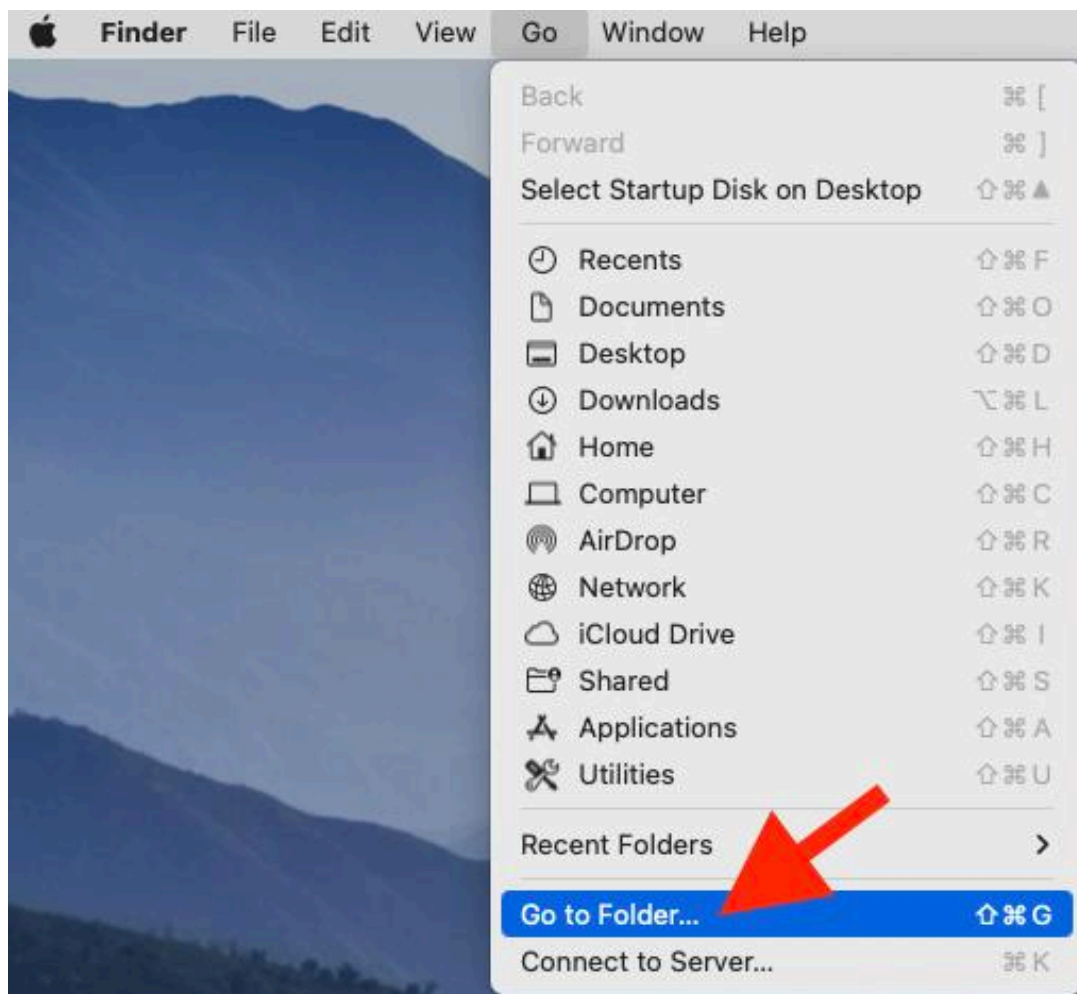


How to Reset Mac's Network Settings

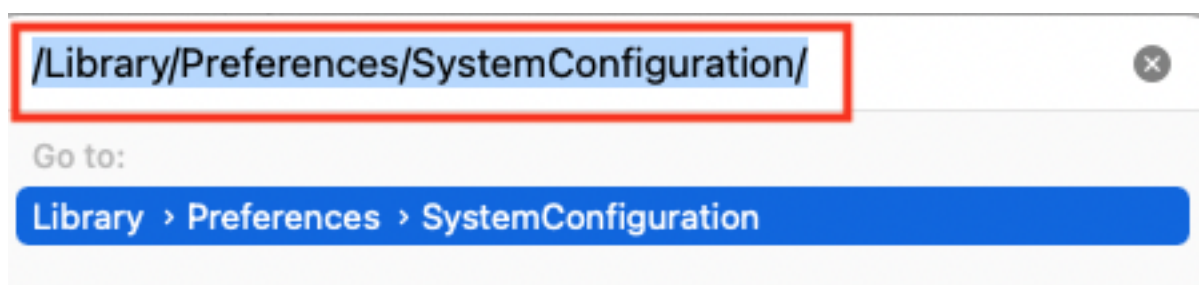
1. Turn off Wi-Fi by clicking the Wi-Fi icon in the top right corner of the menu bar.



2. Go to Finder, click on the Go menu (Command + Shift + G)

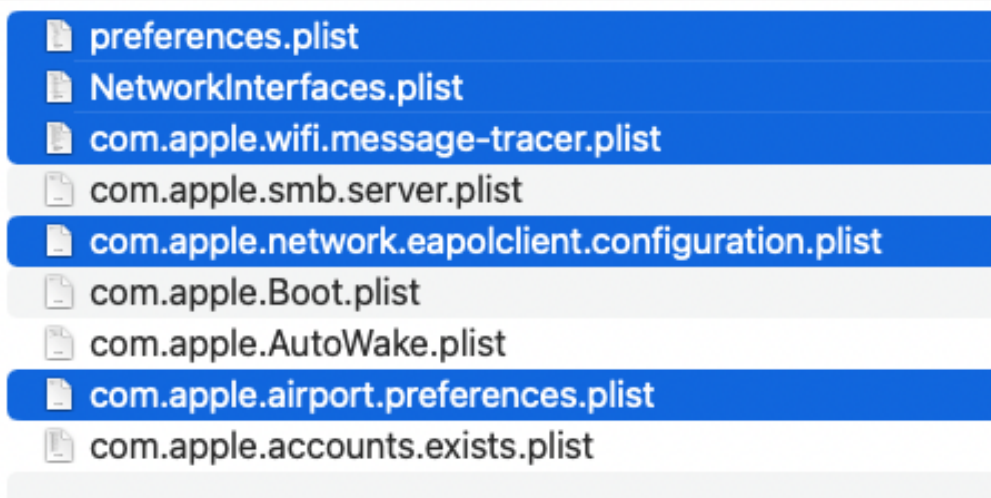


3. Type `/Library/Preferences/SystemConfiguration/` and return



4. This will open a window where you can select the files you want to save them to a safe location as a backup.

- **com.apple.airport.preferences.plist**
- **com.apple.network.identification.plist** or
com.apple.network.eapolclient/configuration.plist
- **com.apple.wifi.message-tracer.plist**
- **NetworkInterfaces.plist**
- **preferences.plist**



5. Now Remove those files. Command + Shift + Delete permanently deleted the files.

6. Restart your Mac as if usual and you can go ahead and delete the files you
